WHAT IS DAF GIVING?

A donor-advised fund (DAF) allows you to recommend how much and how often money is granted to Wounded Warrior Project and other charities. You transfer cash or other assets to a community foundation, financial services firm, or sponsoring organization. You can then recommend — but not direct — how much and how often money is granted.

Setting up a DAF qualifies you for a federal income tax charitable deduction when you make a gift to the fund — without immediately having to choose the charities you want to support. If you so choose, you can support several charitable organizations without having to retain records for several separate contributions.

HOW IT WORKS

1. You open a DAF by written agreement with a community foundation, financial services firm or other sponsoring organization. Most DAFs require a minimum gift to open your fund, although additional contributions may be less.
2. You name your loved ones as your successor to continue recommending grants to charitable organizations, or you can name us as a beneficiary to receive all or part of your account after your lifetime.
3. You may make contributions to your fund at any time. Your sponsoring organization invests contributions and provides you with regular accounting.
4. You qualify for a federal income tax charitable deduction for each gift to your donor-advised fund.
5. You make recommendations that various amounts be distributed to charitable organizations of your choice, such as WWP. However, by law, you cannot make direct distributions.

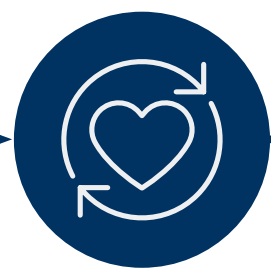


ADVANTAGES

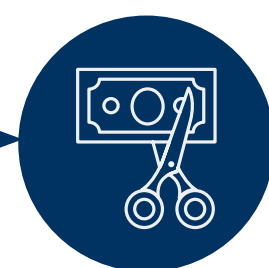
Donors enjoy a certain level of privacy, having the option to keep donations anonymous. These funds are flexible allowing you to add to the fund at any time, and you don't need to have a specific purpose for each gift. Again, the funds offer the simplicity of keeping a multitude of philanthropic activities organized in one stream of documentation and finances.

ADDITIONAL CONSIDERATIONS

Where to find donor-advised funds.

Begin with your local community foundation and nonprofit organizations. Financial services firms also offer a growing number of national donor-advised funds.

Evaluate the sponsoring organization carefully.

When you make a gift to a donor-advised fund, you irrevocably give away your money or property. Make sure the organization you select supports your values.

Understand the fund's policies and procedures.

Minimum contributions, as well as the amount and frequency of grant recommendations, all vary depending upon the sponsoring organization.

Consider costs and investment results.

All donor-advised funds charge administrative fees that can vary considerably. In addition, investment performance will vary from one donor-advised fund to the next, affecting the amount that will actually be distributed to a charitable organization.



MAXIMIZING YOUR DAF: TIPS & TOOLS

Supporting Wounded Warrior Project (WWP) through your Donor-Advised Fund (DAF) can be simple, strategic, and impactful. Below are several ways to make the most of your DAF giving.

Set Up Recurring or Annual Grants

Did you know you can schedule recurring or annual grant recommendations to WWP through your DAF sponsor? This ensures consistent, ongoing support to our warriors and allows you to plan your philanthropy across the year. Simply check with your DAF provider for scheduling options if not available through your giving portal.

Benefits:

- Supports long-term planning and budgeting for WWP programs
- Allows you to stay actively engaged in giving
- Minimizes the need to log in or process grants manually

Name WWP as a Beneficiary or Assign a Successor Advisor

You can make a lasting impact by naming Wounded Warrior Project as a full or partial beneficiary of your DAF. After your lifetime, the remaining assets in your fund can continue to support the causes you care about most.

Alternatively, you can assign a successor advisor, such as a family member, to continue your philanthropic legacy.
